Neighborhood Report: There will be a demolition hearing for 146 University Ave. on March 15th. Work continues on the former Tavern 58, they hope to open sometime in February. Possible sale of Plaza next to Tavern 58 as surveyors were there. Property on SE corner of Main and Scio being cleaned out.

Security/Safety: A letter was written to Mark Siwiec requesting more attention being paid to snow removal on his property's sidewalks. One car break-in reported on Windsor Street. There was a hit and run incident involving a city vehicle. Newspapers were stolen and mailboxes messed with – call 311 if you notice anything unusual.
